FUSION

Product development and innovation is at the heart of growth but often needs costly technology support. InterTradeIreland's FUSION programme can provide that support by helping to fund a high calibre science, engineering or technology graduate, and partnering you with a third level institution with specific expertise. The graduate is based in your company with mentoring from the academic partner and the InterTradeIreland FUSION consultant.

You can choose an 18-month project (typically for new product or service development) or a 12-month project (typically for process improvement) depending on your company's needs. Funding is available up to £56,000/€67,900 for 18-month projects, and up to £39,000/€47,400 for 12-month projects.

On average, each company taking part in the FUSION programme benefits from over £1 million worth of sales or efficiency savings in the three years following the project.

Challenge

Challenge shows business owners how to transform their company's prospects by learning and applying the most effective methods of generating innovative ideas and selecting those with the best chance of success and bringing them to market.

Following an introductory briefing, eligible SMEs will be invited to take part in workshops and then apply for specialist in-house mentoring and support. Challenge leaves SMEs with a proven, adaptable and repeatable innovation process and is free to register and attend.

In a recent independent review, 93% of Challenge participants stated that the programme provided them with 'an innovation system that their management and staff are bought in to'.
